

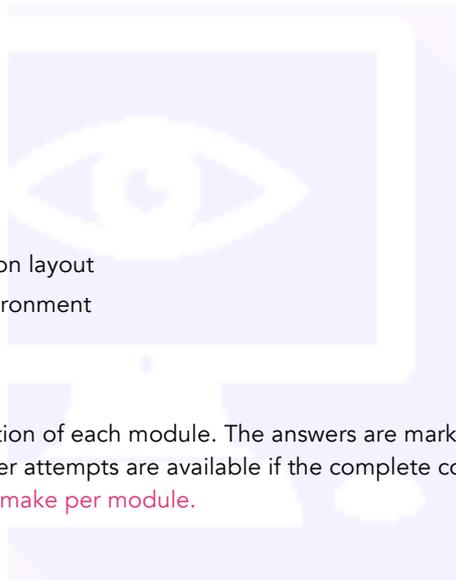
Display Screen Equipment Awareness
